

Executive Board meeting 7 July 2022 Summary of outcomes

The Chair of the Executive Board, Mr Ladislav Hamran, opened the meeting and welcomed the members to the seventeenth meeting in 2022 of the Executive Board of Eurojust.

Main discussions

The Executive Board provided guidance for updating the draft Single Programming Document 2023-2025 and Budget 2023.

The Executive Board took note of the actions and follow-up carried out by the Administrative Director regarding audit, discharge, internal control and risk management matters during the first half of 2022, as presented in the bi-annual report.

The Executive Board decided to accept the request to participate in the TRACE project on cross-border investigations into illicit money flows.

The Executive Board discussed a proposal to hold two environmental crime meetings with external stakeholders to be hosted at Eurojust on 29 and 30 September 2022.
